

- ✓ LAL President the only representative of the library field
- Participation personal initiative of the LAL President
- Result libraries are clearly included in the National Development Plan of Latvia for 2021– 2027 – the highest national-level strategic planning document



2019 Joining the Latvian Multistakeholder Sustainable Development Goals Coalition

- ✓ National Cross-sectoral Coalition for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals was established in October 31, 2019
- Members of the Coalition are individuals and legal entities: NGOs, government, private sector, municipalities, academia, politicians, etc.
- ✓ Activities so far: workshops, discussions, idea and experience exchange
- ✓ The Coalition is operated informally by the Latvian Platform for Development Cooperation
- ✓ LAL purpose: to join a wider community of cooperation partners, make new contacts and draw attention to the importance of libraries in achieving the SDGs

2019–2021 Project «Libraries and sustainable development: we build this world ourselves»

- ✓ Partners: National Library of Latvia, Latvian National Commission for UNESCO
- ✓ Activities: introductory seminar, four regional seminars, closing event (conference), report
- Aim: to actualize the role and involvement of libraries in achieving the SDGs, to discuss the possibilities of libraries to improve the lifes of their communities, to share experience stories about activities that are already being implemented



2021 Conference Localising the Sustainable Development Goals through Baltic museums and libraries

- ✓ Online conference for Estonian, Latvian and Lithuanian museums and libraries on 23–24 September, 2021
- Strong content focus on implementation and evaluation the work with SDGs, incl. political background
- Conference was a clear affirmation that Latvian libraries have moved to another level in the field of SDGs – from the information and awareness raising to strategic action and evaluation





Sākums / Ilgtspējīgas attīstības mērķi (IAM)

Ilgtspeljgas attistibas jedziens definēts 1987. gadā Pasaules Vides un attistības konsijas ziņojumā "Molau kopēja nākome" (Report of the Viorid Commission on Environment and Development: Our Common Future) un starptautiski tiek lietots kopš 1992. gada ANO konfrences Kiodežanetro "Vides Vides" (Auka piespents" "Ricbas plans 2.1. gadsimtam" Aeendo 2.1. lietorielikas attistības acmatieka ja kondrofistā Kodema-valarība valadību aomietinākam. nerado trāvidus nākamo baaudu valadību aomietinākam.

2015. gadā ANO Generālajā asamblejā tika pieņemta rezolūcija Mūsu pasaules pārveidošana: līgtspējīgas attīstības programma 2030. gadam jeb Dienaskartība 2030 (transforming our workt: the 2030 Agendo for Sustainable: Development, Agendozīžos). Tā nosaka 17 līgtspējīgas attīstības mērkus (The Sustainable: Development Goals) un 169 apakšmērķus, kas asaniedzami, lai pasaulē mazinātos nabadzība un pasaules attīstība biolu līgtspējīga. IAM tiek līdzsvaroti trīs dimensijās: ekonomika, sociālie aspekti un vide. IAM turpina Tūkstošgades attīstības mērku (Milemium Development Goals) uzsākto darbu.

IAM ir aktuali visim vaistim un assniedzami tikai kopigiem spēkiem, vieniaikus daja no IAM lietā metā saskan air ar vaistu nocionala ilmena izainājumiem un metijem. Nemot vērā, lak MA apverto tienu toksir saitdinovai pašas, vaistis tisveisa tima aktualiskas metijus, iza ko tašas koncentrēsies tiet 2020. gadam, atbistoš prioritari sasniedzimaliem mēriem aucionāla līmeni, tā pielāgojot IAM savām vajadzībām un iekļaujot vaists attīstības plānošanā konkrētajai valstīju ni sabiedrībai aktualios IAM. Valstis ar augstākiem attīstības rādītājiem, istenojot attīstības sadarību, palīdz sasniegt globālos, visai pasaulei un nākamajām paaudzēm aktualios mēršus, piemēram, nabadzības mazināšana, izglītības iespēju un veiselības aprüpes piegamība.

Dienaskārtība 2030. paredz, ka IAM plānošanā un īstenošanā iesaistās visa sabiedrība, t. sk. - iedzīvotāji, uzņēmēji, politiķi, valstu apvienības, ANO un citas institūcijas.


